Due to recent actions from our current government, I have seen a multitude of people exclaim, "I stand with Israel!" and "We must always support Israel!" I often wonder the reasoning behind these statements. If you are someone who believes that we should support and stand with Israel, I want you to pause for just a second and ask yourself, "Why?" What is your reasoning for why you believe the United States should stand with Israel? Once you have that reason at the front of your mind, see if it lines up with one of the following.

- Is it because you think that America should support any and all countries, which includes Israel?
- Is it simply because of political reasons?
- Is it because America can use Israel and its location to defeat her enemies?
- Is it because of religious reasons?

Oftentimes, those who throw in their supportive words for Israel do so out of purely religious motives. Some of those who call themselves Christians, as well as some actual Christians, believe to some degree that the nation of Israel still constitutes God's holy nation and that God is going to restore the Palestinian land back to the Jews in the future. But is that the case? Does God have a special, unique relationship with the Jews that occupy the area in and around the state of Israel? Is God going to restore the land back to the Jews?

Many years ago God told Abram, "And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed" (Genesis 12:2-3). This promise was fulfilled in part through the establishment of the physical nation of Israel through Abraham's seed in the land of Canaan (Genesis 12:7; 15:8; Joshua 11:23; 21:43-45). That physical nation was the nation of God's people (Deuteronomy 7:6). Over time, God punished and destroyed His nation of Israel because of their constant sin (Leviticus 26:27-39; Deuteronomy 8:19-20; Hosea 13:9). When we think about the Israel of today, that state is about as similar to the Israel of the Old Testament as the American city of Philadelphia is similar to the ancient Philadelphia in Asia. They share the same name, but they are completely different. When you hear about the state of Israel, which began in 1948, please don't equate or connect that nation to the Israelite nation of old. That former covenant that God made with the physical nation of

Israel has become obsolete and God has no desire to restore that covenant once again (Hebrews 8:13).

The Bible is clear that the promise made to Abraham in Genesis 12:2-3 has been fulfilled through the seed of Christ (Galatians 3:16; Acts 3:25-26; Romans 4:13-17). The true, spiritual Israel is the Lord's church that transcends physical borders (Galatians 6:15-16; Romans 9:6-8; Acts 10:34-35). Galatians 3:28-29 says, "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise." We are not Abraham's offspring based on our ethnic background. We are Abraham's offspring because we are in Christ!

The Jews – the people of Israel – had a big part in killing Jesus Christ (Acts 2:36; 7:52). Even God Himself didn't stand with physical Israel once they crucified His own Son. He punished them greatly by sending the Romans to destroy the temple and Jewish records (Matthew 24:1-35). Isn't it ironic that the group who had the biggest part in murdering Jesus is also the same group that many socalled "Christians" are quick to defend on the basis of religion? Isn't it sad that some Christians will go all out to support Israel, yet won't even support their own brothers and sisters in Christ? We certainly should do good to all people, but we need to especially be there for our spiritual family (Galatians 6:10). Some seem to have more respect for physical Israel than they do for Jesus and spiritual Israel, but salvation is not through the physical nation of Israel and its old law (Hebrews 7:18; 8:5-7; 10:1-4). Salvation is only through Jesus (John 14:6; Acts 4:12).

I stand with Israel and you should too. I stand with the Lord's church, which is the true Israel. I stand with the promised spiritual remnant of Abraham's seed through Christ. I honestly don't care one way or the other if America supports the modern-day nation of Israel. I suppose valid political and strategic reasons exist for supporting Israel. There is certainly nothing wrong with America supporting another country, whether it be Israel or somewhere else. There is, however, something wrong with the idea that we should support Israel because we think Israel is God's blessed nation or that God will restore His physical kingdom back to Palestine. I stand with Israel (A.K.A., the church). Do you?
