

Jesus is Lord!

Our gospel meeting with Jeremie Beller begins this Sunday morning. Here's what Jeremie says we can expect with each lesson...

9 a.m. Sunday – “Jesus is Lord: A Counter-cultural Confession.” The focus of the lesson is on the fundamental nature of this confession to who we are. It also looks at how a Jewish audience, a Roman audience, and a modern audience might hear these words. The challenge of the lesson is for the church to understand the implications of this confession in a 21st century context.

10 a.m. Sunday – “Jesus is Lord: A Dangerous Confession.” This sermon focuses on the danger of this confession for the early Christians. It considers the risks of being heard making such a confession in the Roman world while challenging modern Christians to take a strong stand.

6 p.m. Sunday – “If Jesus is Lord, Everything Changes.” This lesson looks at the claim of Jesus as Lord through the Gospel of Matthew. Primarily, chapters 5-10 of Matthew lay the groundwork for what the Kingdom of God, under the Lordship of Jesus, looks like. The lesson focuses on the everyday implications of confessing Jesus as Lord.

7 p.m. Monday – “Whoever Calls on the Name of the Lord: Controversial Confession.” The denominational world often uses the phrase “calling on the name of the Lord” differently than you find in the New Testament. This sermon will show how these words changed Paul's life, and how his baptism

shaped the way he told others to “call on the name of the Lord”.

7 p.m. Tuesday – “Whoever Calls on the Name of the Lord: An Open Invitation.”

Along with the claim that Jesus is Lord, perhaps the most controversial statement comes in the word, “whoever”. Following the book of Acts, this sermon looks at the challenge of the early church in coming to grips with the scope of “everyone” and offers hope that the invitation to Jesus' Lordship remains wide open.

7 p.m. Wednesday – “Jesus is Lord: A Hopeful Confession.”

The New Testament contains an early prayer of the church, “Lord,

come quickly”. The Lordship of Jesus shaped the expectations of judgment and the life to come. This sermon will show how the confession of Jesus as Lord filled the early church with hope and continues to do so.

Jeremie is preparing thoroughly for this effort. What about you? Commit to attend, listen carefully, offer invitations and whatever else will help your friends and family to be there, and be a welcoming host. Pray that as a result people will call on the name of the Lord for salvation and that we as a church will live up to our confession more faithfully than ever.
