You deserve an update on a good work that you support!

The upgrades at Green Valley Bible Camp are rolling along. The renovation of the first girls' bathhouse will be finished in time for camp. Clean, 21st-century surfaces will greet the campers and counselors and make their job a lot easier as they clean the facility during the week. They'll find more privacy and more space to do whatever they do to get ready for the day and to end the day. The public restrooms at the pool house are also being upgraded a little. The Department of Transportation has installed a new, safer bridge at the camp entrance at minimal cost to us. This is just the beginning. When this camp season ends we'll keep working toward an additional bathhouse for the girls, a renovation of the boys' bathhouse, a new worship pavilion and a new cafeteria.

We're doing everything we can to get quality results while controlling costs. The bathhouse renovation is being completed for less than we projected. Architectural services for upcoming projects are being donated by a brother as training for his interns. As I told you previously, our total fundraising goal over the next few years is \$1.3 million. We were able to start with some \$300,000 thanks especially to a gift given years ago. Since we started telling you our plans and asking for your help last fall, Christians have given more than \$267,000 to the cause! Please stay involved as we keeping making improvements.

Our week at camp is only 26 days away! That week we will study 26 good ways God gives us to see ourselves in Christ. At present, we need to provide scholarships for four campers; we may learn of more who need help by the time camp starts. Participation in the week costs \$123.03. Any amount you donate will help and be appreciated.

Thank you for your participation financially, in prayer, and in helping to spread the word about what we are doing. Thank you most of all for the opportunity to work with you in the mission of making young people disciples of Christ.
