If you were in attendance at both services on Sunday and our Wednesday night service, you have heard three lessons in a row that each contained Mark 16:15. In this verse Jesus told His disciples, “Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation.” This is one of the main purposes of being Christ-like. After all, Jesus’ mission was to seek and save the lost (Luke 19:10). We have focused many of our recent thoughts in corporate worship on what the Bible says about evangelism, and thankfully, that has translated to us actually being evangelistic!

On Sunday morning I informed you all about the great *World Bible School* program. From Sunday morning to Tuesday evening we have had six souls in our area sign up at *World Bible School* to do the studies. If it hadn’t been for you all getting the word out, these six people probably wouldn’t be connected with *WBS*. Good job and keep up the advertising, sharing, and posting!

In addition to these encouraging happenings from the past three days, I am working on some specific flyers to give our to those in our community who are Spanish speaking. Look for those on the welcome desk in the coming weeks. Also, remember to hand out your flyer in the next 71 hours and 58 minutes. You all are amazing and please remember that your work for the Lord has not been overlooked by Him (Hebrews 6:10).
